OVERVIEW

Our Earth Handprint Art project works great on Earth day or any day of the year. It is a fun activity to do individually or with others. Let's start!


APPROXIMATE TIME: 30 MINUTES TO 1 HOUR

MATERIALS

To make this project, you will need:

- White cardstock
- Large paper or an old sheet for painting
- Green craft paint
- Blue craft paint
- Paint brushes
- Large round container or bowl
- Pencil
- Scissors







INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The white cardstock will represent our Earth. Decide the size of your cardstock, based on how large you would like your Earth to be.
- 2. Use a large round container or bowl, and a pencil to trace a circle onto the white cardstock. Cut out the circle on your cardstock with scissors.
- 3. Place the circle white cardstock over a large sheet of paper or an old sheet to get ready for painting.
- 4. Start making your handprints by painting the blue area. Paint your hand blue and press it onto the circle white cardstock.
- 5. Allow the blue paint on your circle white cardstock to dry. In the meantime, remove the blue paint from your hands by washing them.
- 6. Now, you can paint your green area. Paint your hand green and press it onto the circle white cardstock, focusing on the areas that are not filled in yet.
- 7. Wait for it to dry and admire your Earth Handprint Art!
