

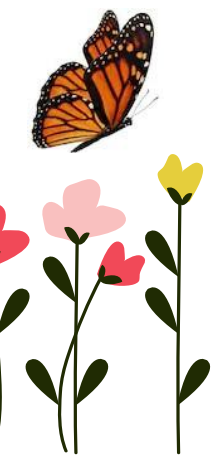
POLLINATOR PALS
