

# JADE PLANT

## Crassula Ovata



### About

Also known as money trees or lucky plants, jade plants are succulents native to South Africa and Mozambique. Succulents store water in their thick leaves, and can survive in drier environments. Jade plants are easy to care for, making them a popular indoor plant.

### Care

**Light:** Direct, bright to medium sunlight.

**Soil:** jade plants prefer sandier soil that drains well. You can also put pebbles in the bottom of your planter if it doesn't have holes.

**Water:** water about every other week, when the first 1-2cm of soil get dry. Try not to over-water!

### Pets

Jade plants can make dogs and cats sick if they eat its leaves, and can sometimes cause serious problems, so keep it out of reach of pets!
