Education Pathway to become Urban Agriculture Manager?

The pathway to becoming an urban agriculture manager may depend on your future employer. Those some basic requirements include:

1. Bachelor's Degree – a degree in agriculture, horticulture, or environmental science would make sure you have a foundation in the field

2. Master's Degree - a degree in urban planning, and business management would make sure you have skills in project management

3. Professional certifications - some jobs require Certified Crop Adviser (CCA) certification and a Certified Urban Agriculturist (CUA) certification to show that you are serious about the job and field
